Cable Bay's wines are known for their elegance and subtlety. The vineyard is perched on the side of a hill with wonderful views back to Auckland City.

Our afternoon tour includes a visit to Rangihoua Estate where the first olive oil in New Zealand's North Island was produced. Rangihoua's award-winning olive oils have won many accolades since the first pressings. Here you will learn how the oil is produced and taste a range of different oils. The Frantoio blend has just been listed as one of the Top 20 Olive Oils in the world – Flos Olei 2013!

Our visit to Waiheke Island wouldn't be complete without making time for a stroll along the golden sands of Onetangi Beach and an ice-cream or refreshments as desired.

The return ferry to Auckland brings us back in time for a relaxed dinner at a stunning waterfront location.
